Parking Policy



Public Space Parking

Public space parking, or the parking spots located off Garfield Ave. (South Lot), are intended for the public patrons of the Alpha Park Library. This is to mean that while patrons are using the library or library resources, this parking lot will be made available free of cost. This includes using the wireless internet (Wi-Fi) services, participating in library programming, or enjoying the library for its intended use as an open, safe, and public space.

Individuals utilizing the parking lot spots to conduct illegitimate or wrongful business, establish residence, or parking that is repeatedly outside of the lines or causes inconvenience to other patrons shall be addressed and rectified immediately. If a complaint is received on behalf of the vehicle's position or condition, it will be addressed by the Library Director. The public user, or patron, will need to rectify the issue immediately. If the issue is a consistent and ongoing problem, the vehicle in question will be towed at the owner's expense.

Overnight Parking

Overnight parking that is intentional, repeated, and ongoing is strictly prohibited. Occasional overnight parking that is the result of a temporary setback or mishap is exceptional and may be condoned with the permission of the Library Director.

Staff Parking

The staff lot of the Alpha Park Library shall park their vehicles in the North Lot when available, leaving the South Lot open and available for patrons. On occasion, it is known that there will be a need for overflow parking for the public. Overflow parking in the staff lot is acceptable during special events. Whenever possible, vendor parking should work to accommodate the needs of the Alpha Park Library patrons.
